The report will include the number of women who are recommended for treatment, admitted to treatment and whether they were admitted to a Designated Women's Facility.

To assure Pregnant Women and Women with children are being admitted to Designated Women's Facilities.

Data was collected from the KCPC data files and plcmcris. The report includes women who are pregnant and/or women who have children. The reporting period is applied to the Assessment Date (Assessment Date; pulled from the interview date in the client file).

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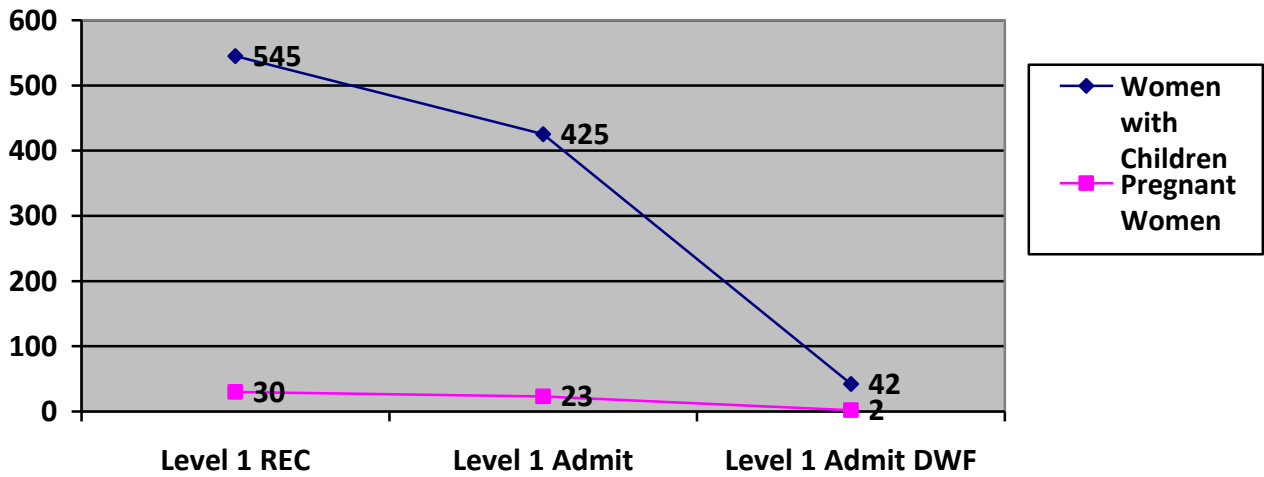

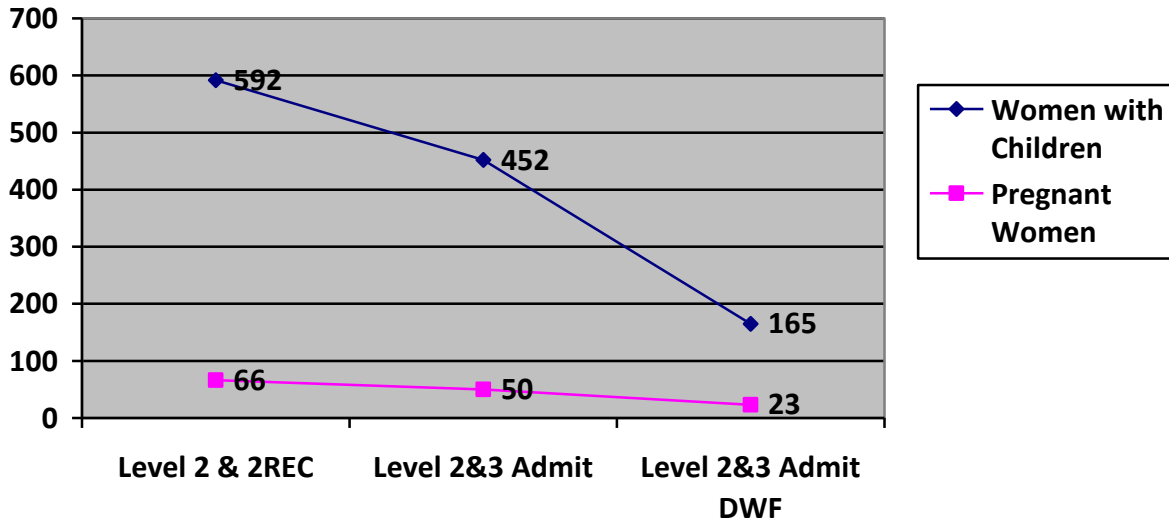

Conclusion:

- 7.70% of Women with Children admitted to SUD Treatment (Level 1 modality) utilize a Designated Women's Treatment Program.
- 27.9% of Women with Children admitted to Treatment (Level 2&3 modality) utilize a Designated Women's Treatment Program.
- 6.66% of Pregnant Women admitted to SUD Treatment (Level 1 modality) utilize a Designated Women's Treatment Program.
- 34.8% of Pregnant Women admitted to SUD Treatment (Level 2&3) utilize a Designated Women's Treatment Program.
- 23.3% of Pregnant Women who are recommended to Level 1 treatment do not attend.
- 24.2% of Pregnant Women who are recommended to Level 2 & 3 treatment do not attend.
- 22.0% of Women with Children who are recommended to Level 1 treatment do not attend.
- 23.6% of Women with Children who are recommended to Level 2 & 3 treatment do not attend.

Preliminary Recommendations to Committee:

- It is recommended that data continue to be trended and provider education continue regarding the access standards in the coming months.
