**Goal:**

The PIHP will track and report quarterly to SRS/AAPS adult and youth discharged to homeless shelters.

**Objectives:**

To assure the documentation is capturing this data

To evaluate for trends that may require system intervention

To allow data to be presented consistently for Committee evaluation and response

**Data Collection Activities:**

Data was collected by the PIHP from the KCPC and the Homeless Discharge Report. The data collected is the best information we currently have available, but may not show a true measure of homelessness due to the way the KCPC captures this data. There is a disparity in how this data is captured based on whether a member is discharged due to an agency decision or a member's decision (AMA).

**For Youth:** The report shall include why the discharge was chosen and the names of those who gave consent to the discharge. The report will capture data for youth discharged to homeless shelters. The data will be reported separately by AAPS and Medicaid funding source.

**For Adults:** The report shall include why the discharge was chosen. The report will capture data for adults discharged to homeless shelters. The data will be reported separately by AAPS and Medicaid funding source.

**Results:**

This report has undergone major revision since the FY2010 aggregate based upon the new methodology. Per the State's request in March 2011, ValueOptions-KS now provides the ultimate disposition of whether the client is homeless or not based upon the federal definition of homelessness and two summaries (one by provider and one by modality of care) based upon the ultimate disposition.

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Provider Summary not shown due to provider-specific data. Only 11 providers reported an adult discharged to homelessness during FY2011.

**Conclusions:**

- The most adults reported to be discharged to homelessness each quarter and for FYTD are in Level III.2-D (Social Detox). The least adults reported to be discharged to homelessness YTD are in Level II (Intensive Outpatient).
- Adults discharged to homelessness has increased over FY2011 (Q1 = 10, Q2 = 10, Q3 = 14, Q4 = 26).
- For FY2011, there were 3 Medicaid funded adults discharged to homelessness, and 57 AAPS funded adults discharged to homelessness.
- For FY2011, there were 29 adults reported to be discharged to homelessness in the Northeast region, 20 adults reported in the Kansas City region, 8 adults reported in the Wichita region, 2 adults reported in the West region and 1 adult reported in the Southeast region.
- Due to the revisions discussed above, a fiscal year comparison was not done.

**Preliminary Recommendations to Committee:**

- It is recommended by the Committee that this aggregate analysis be posted on the ValueOptions website.
- **It is recommended by the Committee for the State (Stacy) and VO (Chris) to meet and create a Frequently Asked Questions (FAQ) document regarding National Outcome Measures (NOMs) definitions to assist providers and then distribute to the provider network.**
