Interim Services Definitions

Block Grant definition - Per the Code of Federal Regulations for Block Grant, CFR 45 96.121 "At a minimum, interim services include counseling and education about HIV and tuberculosis (TB), about the risks of needle-sharing, the risks of transmission to sexual partners and infants, and about steps that can be taken to ensure that HIV and TB transmission does not occur, as well as referral for HIV or TB treatment services if necessary. For pregnant women, interim services also include counseling on the effects of alcohol and drug use on the fetus, as well as referral for prenatal care".

Substance abuse interim services (any member) - providing a lower level of care than that recommended while the member is waiting to be seen in the higher level of care.
